Mixed use structures shall have the residential portions covered under the Residential Agreement and the commercial portions constructed under the applicable Commercial Agreement. (Please refer to the contract language). The new agreement incorporates the Vacation Savings Plan as part of the economic package and continues to allow each employer to designate one (1) individual exemption from the 160 Hour Rule requirements under Sections 12.11, 13.9, and 14.9 under the terms of the Side Letter Agreement.

APPRENTICES

The Apprentice wage rate throughout all listed counties shall be as follows:

1st year 40% of Journeyman's wages

2nd year 50% of Journeyman's wages

3rd year 65% of Journeyman's wages

4th year 80% of Journeyman's wages
